<u>Serious or life-threatening injuries should be handled by calling 911. The paperwork can be</u> filled out after the seriously injured person has started treatment.

- 1. Remove victim from threat of further injury
 - a. Inform the PI and group safety officer of the incident as soon as possible
- 2. Injury Occurs During Regular Business Hours (Mon-Fri, 8am-8pm)
 - a. Inform Department Administration to help get Workers Compensation paperwork started

 - ii. Jonathan Karty 812-855-4619 (room 125F, jkarty@iu.edu)
 - b. If the person requires off-site medical attention, Employer Notification for Treatment Form must be filled out https://iuhr-fireform.eas.iu.edu/online/form/index/entiub (requires IU login)
 - i. MUST be filled out PRIOR TO GOING TO THE DOCTOR if possible.
 - ii. Injured person must go to IU Health Occupational Services at 3443 W. Third St. (Mon-Fri 8am 8 pm, Sat 8am 6pm), 812-353-3443.
 - 1. IUPD will NOT transport injured parties to health care facilities
 - iii. Inform medical staff that this is an Indiana University Workers Compensation claim
- 3. Injury Occurs After Business Hours
 - a. Call IUPD dispatch 812-855-4111 if a dangerous chemical spill is involved
 - b. Fill out Employer Notification for Treatment Form https://iuhr-fireform.eas.iu.edu/online/form/authen/entiub
 - c. If PI or lab alternate emergency contact is unavailable call:
 - i. Jonathan Karty (812-855-4619 forwards to his cell)
 - ii. Chad Schaeffer (812-855-2241 forwards to his cell)
 - d. Injured person can go to
 - i. IU Health Urgent Care, 326 S. Woodcrest Dr. (Mon-Fri, 8am-8pm, Sat-Sun 8am-6pm)
 - ii. IU Health Urgent Care, 482 S. Liberty Dr. (Mon-Fri, 8am-8pm, Sat-Sun 8am-6pm)
 - iii. Bloomington Hospital at 2651 E. Discovery Parkway (always open)
 - 1. IUPD will NOT transport injured parties to health care facilities
 - e. Inform medical staff that this is an Indiana University Workers Compensation claim
- 4. By the end of the next business day!
 - a. Complete the IU Occupational Injury/Illness form found here. http://hr.iu.edu/workers/occ_form.html
 - b. If a chemical was involved in the injury, please complete the Spill or Incident Follow Up report https://protect.iu.edu/machform/view.php?id=40365
